STAGE 1

Prevention

No confirmed cases of COVID-19 among staff or students

- Health prevention measures are in place.
- Daily intensive cleaning and frequent cleaning of commons areas.
- Limited visitor access.
- Monitoring virus trends in the community via health departments.

STAGE 2

Mitigation

One or more confirmed case(s) of COVID-19 on campus

- Person(s) who came in close contact of an individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19 will be notified and advised to follow most up to date guidance.
- Affected area undergoes deep cleaning.
- Communications are sent those who were in shared spaces but not close contact, as well as a general notification to the community.

STAGE 3

Modified Operations

Confirmed COVID-19 cases in one specific area reaches 10%

- Individuals in that area will be advised to follow most up to date guidance per CDC guidelines.
- Students who were in close contact
- Affected area is closed for deep cleaning.
- Self-health monitoring, prevention information, and stay home if ill reminders sent.

STAGE 4

Campus Closure

Suspected/Confirmed COVID-19 cases exceed 10% of total enrollment and employees

- Entire facility and activities will be closed for a minimum of two days.
- If closure is longer than two days, students will move to remote synchronous learning.
- Those in close contact of the confirmed COVID-19 positive persons will be notified and are to follow CDC guidelines.
- Disinfection of all facilities.
- All auxiliary areas such as athletic fields are closed.
- Extracurricular activities are cancelled.
